



What is Beach Pups?

Beach Pups is an introductory surf life saving program aimed for children under the age of 5 before they begin Nippers. Its purpose is to develop children's understanding of surf awareness and how to play safely at the beach, whilst being in a supportive, fun and encouraging environment.

When is Beach Pups?

Beach Pups will commence at 9:15am on the following Sunday mornings:

- 11 November 2018
- 25 November 2018
- 2 December 2018
- 16 December 2018 (Christmas Party)
- 10 February 2019
- 24 February 2019
- 17 March 2019
- 24 March 2019 (Nipper Presentation Day)

Each session will last approximately 40 minutes.

How does my child become involved?

If you would like your child to be a Beach Pup this season, you will need to:
